


15 minute neighbourhood study






Organisation interviews

1-1 interviews with all user organisations currently using the centre


Listening to how they use the centre and how they would like to use the centre in the future

More small flexible spaces, Community rooms, office and meeting rooms. Spaces for hire to community groups to be based there while also bringing in a source of income for the centre


